Now, I can hear you asking... what if you never use your front door?

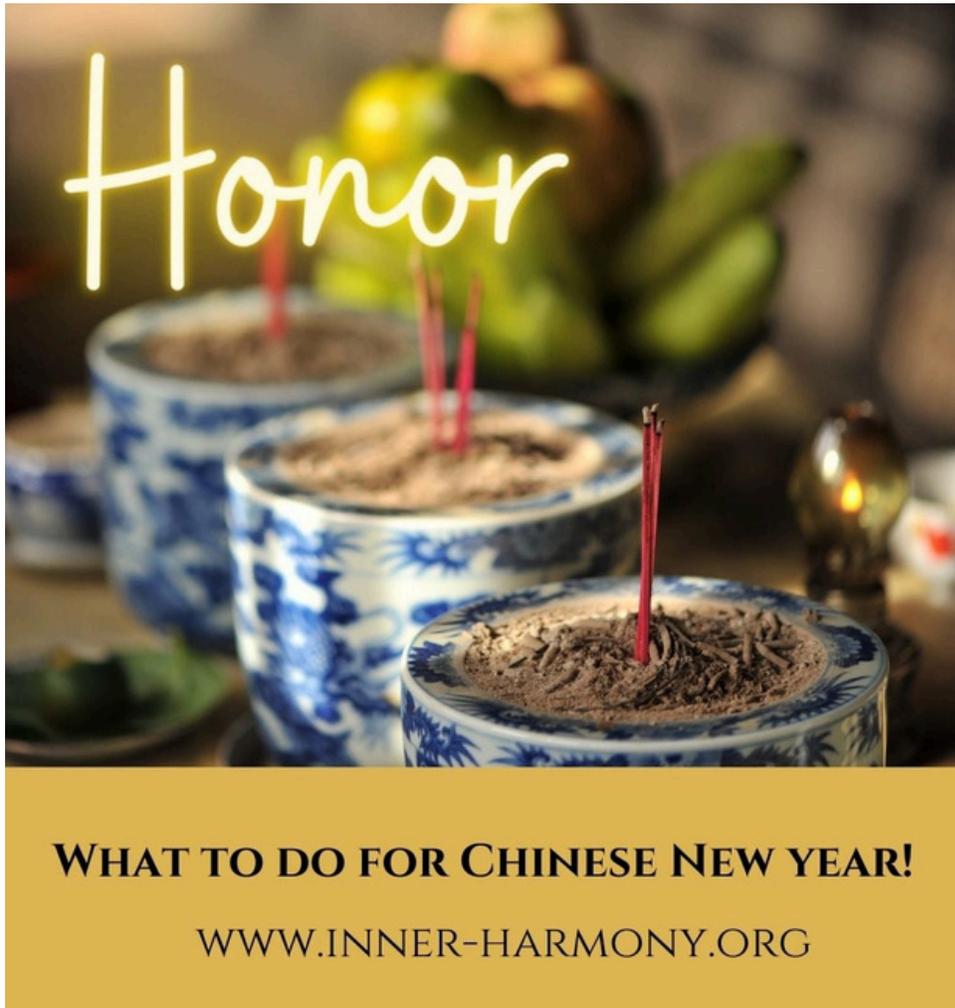

If not, now is the perfect time to create one!



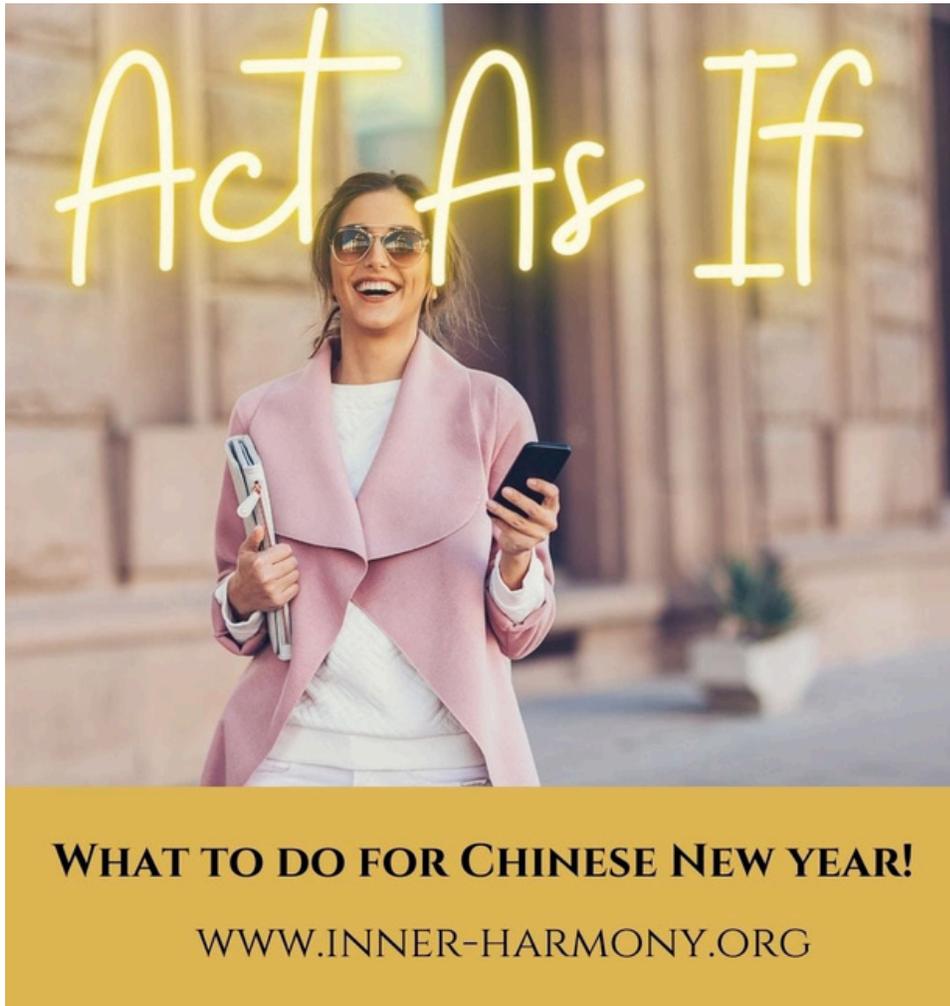
GIFTS

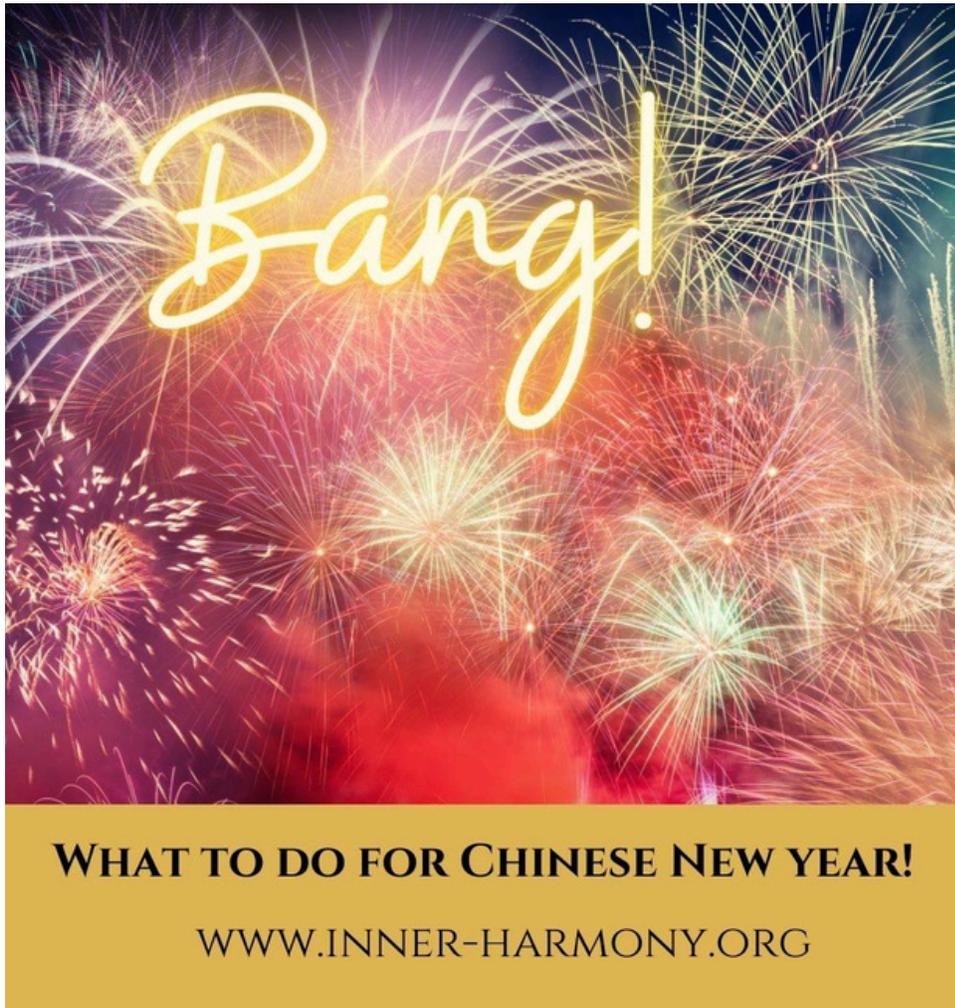
